
Summer Camp designed for Ages 18 Mo- 9 Years

Witches & Wizards



Camp fees for Little Tykes (age 18 mo-30 mo) and Discovery Junior (2.5 years to 3.8 years) include a daily lunch and two snacks provided by Wholesome Food Catering Company. Discovery (3.9 years to 5 years) and Discovery Senior Campers (6 years to 9 years) will be required to bring a daily lunch and two snacks.

Your camp fees also include a free camp t-shirt to wear at camp and keep as a great memory of your camp experience. Little Tykes and Discovery camps run on a five full days a week basis. CAMP GUIDELINES

ARRIVALS AND DEPARTURES

Please arrive by 9 AM.

Departure time for the camp program is 4 PM. Any family using aftercare that does not pick up their camper by 5:30 PM. may be subject to a \$1 per minute charge for the first 5 minutes and a \$5 per minute charge for every minute after the initial 5 minutes. This charge is per camper.

If you need to pick up or drop off your camper at any time other than the designated arrival and departure times, please call (905) 852-6377 so we have them ready to go.

Please use the FRONT DOORS OF THE SCHOOL to drop off and pick up your children.

LUNCH AND SNACKS

Campers on the Lunch/Snack program will be provided with a lunch and two snacks daily. Children on the Lunch program need to bring a non-breakable plate, bowl, cup and utensils in a washable, reusable bag. Dishes will be rinsed and returned daily to be washed. If a child is not participating in the lunch program, they need to bring a lunch and snacks packed in a reusable bag and contained in non-breakable containers.

Families are expected to let Camp Administration know of any allergies or intolerances on the Camp Registration form or by email at camp@uxbridgemontessori.com.



WHAT TO BRING

- Water bottle (no glass please)
- Sunscreen sunscreen needs to be applied in the morning before arriving at camp. It will be reapplied at camp for the afternoon.
- Sun hat
- Closed toe shoes running shoes work best for camp. No Crocs, flip flops or open toe sandals please. Campers will wear the same shoes indoor and outdoors.
- Extra clothing please send an extra set of socks, underwear, shorts, pants and t-shirt to keep at camp for the week
- Rain gear or jacket appropriate for the weather. We DO go outside in the rain if it's safe to do so.
- Bedding for campers who will be napping. For any camper under the age of 3 who will not be napping, we require a note from parents stating that they do not need to nap.

What not to bring: Toys, valuables, money or electronics from home, umbrellas



CAMP GUIDELINES

MEDICATIONS

If your child requires medication during camp, please let your Camp Leader know so they can provide you with the Administration of Medication form for completion and signature. We are not allowed to administer over-the-counter or prescribed medication without completion of this form.

CANCELLATIONS

Changes or cancellation of chosen weeks of camp must be done at least one week (7 days) prior to the start of the camp by emailing camp@uxbridgemontessori.com

Refunds will be provided as long as notification is given at least 7 days prior to the start of the camp week.

IN CASE OF ILLNESS

If a child becomes ill at camp, parents will be called to come and pick them up. Children need to be picked up within an hour or the Emergency contacts will be called.

If a child has a fever, they cannot return to camp until they are 24 hours fever free.

If a child has diarrhea or vomiting, they cannot return to camp until 48 hours after the last episode.

VISITORS

Each week the camp hosts a visitor. The Fee for this is calculated prior to the start of camp and we aim for the cost to be around \$20 (but for really awesome visitors we sometimes go over this budget). Permission forms and costs will be made known to our parents well in advance.
