DISCOVERY CAMP SCHEDULE

WEEK 1

Galactic Explorers

Set out on an interstellar adventure with a cosmic-themed week for campers. Activities include stargazing, crafting mini-rocket ships, and thrilling space missions. Campers will learn about gravity and black holes through interactive experiments, create alien life forms, and design futuristic space colonies, ensuring an exciting and imaginative experience! (*4 day Week)

WEEK 2

Ocean Voyagers

Campers will explore ocean life through activities like an underwater safari, mythical mermaids, and water-based games. They'll learn about ocean conservation, create sea creature crafts, and participate in scavenger hunts and deep-sea explorations. The week promises creative storytelling and hands-on experiments focused on protecting marine ecosystems, ensuring fun and adventure.

WEEK 3

Wildlife Safari

Join an exciting journey through diverse ecosystems, where campers will learn about exotic animals and conservation. Activities include guided nature walks, storytelling, hands-on animal encounters, and interactive exhibits. Campers will also participate in nature-inspired crafts and eco-friendly projects, culminating in an animal-tracking adventure to uncover hidden wildlife clues.

WEEK 4

Treasure Island

Join our pirate-themed camp for a week of adventures, including treasure hunts, map decoding, and pirate gear creation. Campers will learn pirate lingo, build treasure chests, navigate obstacle courses, and develop teamwork skills through scavenger hunts and storytelling. They'll also make pirate flags and participate in a water battle, earning official pirate badges by the end of the week.

WEEK 5

Magic Academy

Join a magical adventure where aspiring witches and wizards will create potions, practice spell-casting, and immerse themselves in imaginative role-playing. Campers will craft wands, design spellbooks, and engage in wizard duels while conducting chemistry experiments that mimic real magic. They will also hunt for magical creatures, solving riddles and discovering surprises. A week filled with wonder and mystery awaits!

WEEK 6

Secret Agent Challenge

Young detectives will engage in a thrilling week of problem-solving, uncovering clues, and solving mysteries. Campers will learn detective techniques like fingerprint analysis and cipher decoding while participating in spy-themed obstacle courses and escape-room-style puzzles. By the end of the week, they will graduate as elite secret agents, prepared for their next big case! (*4 day week)

WEEK 7

Survival Quest

This action-packed week equips campers with essential survival skills, including building shelters, navigating with a compass, starting campfires, finding safe food, and purifying water. Participants engage in team challenges that test their resilience and adaptability, while guided nature hikes offer experience in identifying plants and animal tracks. Through hands-on activities and adventure games, campers build confidence and self-reliance in the outdoors.

WEEK 8

Creative Canvas

Join this artistic adventure where campers will explore various art forms, including painting, sculpting, and digital art. They'll draw inspiration from famous artists and movements to create their own masterpieces through projects like mural painting and recycled sculptures. A mini art exhibition at the week's end will showcase their work, helping young artists develop their talents and confidence in creativity.

Camp fees for Little Tykes (age 18 mo-30 mo) and Discovery Junior (2.5 years to 3.8 years) include a daily lunch and two snacks provided by Wholesome Food Catering Company. Discovery (3.9 years to 5 years) and Discovery Senior Campers (6 years to 9 years) will be required to bring a daily lunch and two snacks.

Your camp fees also include a free camp t-shirt to wear at camp and keep as a great memory of your camp experience. Little Tykes and Discovery camps run on a five full days a week basis. Camp fees may be paid by postdated cheque, cash, or email transfer to payments@uxbridgemonessori.com. CAMP GUIDELINES

ARRIVALS AND DEPARTURES

Please arrive by 9 AM.

Departure time for the camp program is 4 PM. Any family using aftercare that does not pick up their camper by 5:30 PM. may be subject to a \$1 per minute charge for the first 5 minutes and a \$5 per minute charge for every minute after the initial 5 minutes. This charge is per camper.

If you need to pick up or drop off your camper at any time other than the designated arrival and departure times, please call (905) 852-6377 so we have them ready to go.

Please use the FRONT DOORS OF THE SCHOOL to drop off and pick up your children.

LUNCH AND SNACKS

Campers on the Lunch/Snack program will be provided with a lunch and two snacks daily. Children on the Lunch program need to bring a non-breakable plate, bowl, cup and utensils in a washable, reusable bag. Dishes will be rinsed and returned daily to be washed. If a child is not participating in the lunch program, they need to bring a lunch and snacks packed in a reusable bag and contained in non-breakable containers.

Families are expected to let Camp Administration know of any allergies or intolerances on the Camp Registration form or by email at camp@uxbridgemonessori.com.



WHAT TO BRING

- Water bottle (no glass please)
- Sunscreen – sunscreen needs to be applied in the morning before arriving at camp. It will be reapplied at camp for the afternoon.
- Sun hat
- Closed toe shoes – running shoes work best for camp. No Crocs, flip flops or open toe sandals please. Campers will wear the same shoes indoor and outdoors.
- Extra clothing – please send an extra set of socks, underwear, shorts, pants and t-shirt to keep at camp for the week
- Rain gear or jacket appropriate for the weather. We DO go outside in the rain if it's safe to do so.
- Bedding for campers who will be napping. For any camper under the age of 3 who will not be napping, we require a note from parents stating that they do not need to nap.

What not to bring: Toys, valuables, money or electronics from home, umbrellas



CAMP GUIDELINES

MEDICATIONS

If your child requires medication during camp, please let your Camp Leader know so they can provide you with the Administration of Medication form for completion and signature. We are not allowed to administer over-the-counter or prescribed medication without completion of this form.

VISITORS

Each week the camp hosts a visitor. The Fee for this is calculated prior to the start of camp and we aim for the cost to be around \$20 (but for really awesome visitors we sometimes go over this budget). Permission forms and costs will be made known to our parents well in advance.

IN CASE OF ILLNESS

If a child becomes ill at camp, parents will be called to come and pick them up. Children need to be picked up within an hour or the Emergency contacts will be called.

If a child has a fever, they cannot return to camp until they are 24 hours fever free.

If a child has diarrhea or vomiting, they cannot return to camp until 48 hours after the last episode.

CANCELLATIONS

Full Refund by June 30th

A full refund will be issued for cancellations made by June 30th. An administrative charge of \$25 per week will be deducted from the refund amount. A written notice of cancellation must be provided at least one week in advance to the start date of camp to qualify for the refund.

Partial Refund after July 1st

After July 1st, cancellations will be eligible for a 50% refund. A written notice of cancellation must be provided at least one week in advance to the start date of camp to qualify for the refund.

If a cheque is returned for any reason (eg. N.S.F.), a charge \$25.00 will be levied. All children must be picked up by the end of camp hours. Parents are subject to a late pick up charge of \$1.00 per minute after 12:00pm (for half day campers), and 5:30pm (for full day campers).
